A Letter from the Nurse;

As we return to a “new normal” for us here at Seligman USD, there are a few considerations of great importance for parents and caregivers, especially regarding COVID 19. Safety is going to be a great concern. The following information provided will be requirements in the Nurse/Health office.

If any student presents to the Nurse for evaluation with COVID like symptoms, that student will be sent home. Parents will be required to arrive at the school in a very timely manner. We cannot expose other staff and students to this potentially dangerous virus for any longer than needed. After leaving the school, parents/caregivers will be strongly urged to contact a physician for an appointment for diagnosis. If the Doctor finds that the student does not have COVID, then the student MUST have a note from the Doctor stating that they do not have COVID. The student may then return to school after signs and symptoms have subsided, and the student is free of fever for 24 hours without a fever reducer such as Tylenol. If the Doctor isn't sure, or no testing is done, or parent/caregiver does not take student to the Doctor, then the student may return to school only after they have quarantined for 10 days from the onset of signs and symptoms. Again, the student must be free of signs and symptoms, and no fever for 24 hours without a fever reducer before returning to school. If student has COVID, it is very important that the school be notified. Other students and staff will have been exposed and will be making their own decisions affecting their health concerns.

We will greatly appreciate your cooperation in caring for your student, as we move forward in this new school year. Please feel free to contact the Nurse's office with any questions or concerns that you might have.
