Seligman On-site Learning Opportunities and Support Services

Beginning on August 17, 2020, Seligman School will begin offering free on-site learning opportunities and support services for students who need a place to go during the school day under Governor Ducey’s Executive Order 2020-41 and 2020-51.

- Please be advised that free on-site learning opportunities and support services **are not** teacher-led classroom instruction. However, free on-site learning opportunities and support services will include in-person support services such as student supervision and strategic support for students in need during standard school hours, and may include teacher-led or paraprofessional support for students engaging in distance learning instruction.
- Beginning Monday, August 17, 2020 at 8am invited students who will participate in this Learning Opportunities and Support Services will enter thru the main office with their parent/guardians.
- All students will be temperature checked in the office and then Mr. Phillips will escort the student(s) to the Elementary School. All students will wear a mask when entering school grounds. If the student does not have a cloth mask, one will be provided.
- Kindergarten students will be placed in Ms. Akot’s Kindergarten classroom Room 103.
- All other students will be placed in Room 112 with Mrs. Austill.
- Breakfast and lunch will be delivered to those 2 classrooms for those participating the meal program.
- Teachers or paraprofessionals working with those students are required to wear a mask.
- All safety protocols from the school Mitigation Plan will be followed by all students and staff who are directly involved in the On-Site Opportunities program.
- Students are allowed to attend Monday through Thursday during normal school hours 8am-3:40pm. Students are not mandated to attend every day and for the length of the school day. That will be determined by the parent/guardian of each student.
