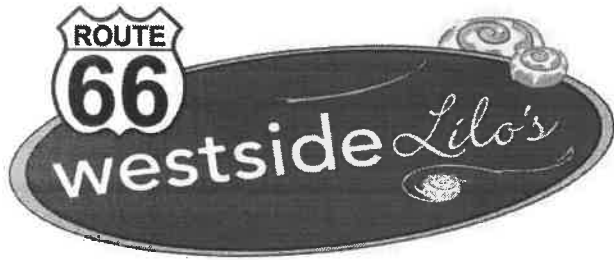

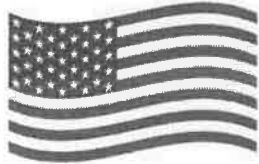

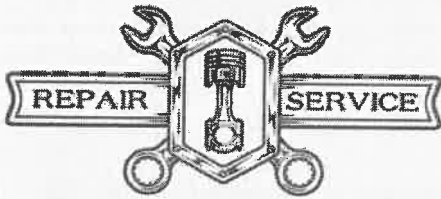

Yavapai County Recorder, Leslie Hoffman would like to remind voters about important information regarding the upcoming 2022 Primary Election being held Tuesday, August 2, 2022.

All registered voters are eligible to vote in the 2022 Primary Election.

If you are a registered Independent, Other, or Party Not Designated and are on the Active Early Voter List, you must tell us which Party Ballot you want mailed. Call 928-771-3248 ext. 9.

Ballots will be mailed to voters requesting Automatic Ballot-by-Mail on Wednesday, July 6, 2022. Be sure to sign your ballot affidavit envelope in your original handwriting.

Voters may vote early in-person or vote a replacement ballot beginning Wednesday, July 6 - 29, 2022, at the Yavapai County Recorder's Office - 1015 Fair St., Prescott, M - F 8am - 5pm. Proper identification is required.

The last day to request an Early Ballot be mailed to you is Friday, July 22, 2022. Call 928-771-3248 ext. 9 or visit yavapaivotes.gov to request a one-time early ballot.

Please consider returning your voted ballot using one of our 19 Official Ballot Drop Boxes located throughout the County. This saves Yavapai County 65.5¢ per ballot in tax dollars. Visit yavapaivotes.gov for locations.

DO NOT mail your voted ballot back after Tuesday, July 26, 2022. Late ballots will not be tabulated.

Yavapai County School Superintendent Tim Carter is pleased to announce the appointment of **Rebecca (Becky) Austill, to the Seligman Unified School District Governing Board.** The appointment will be effective July 8, 2022 and will expire on December 31, 2024.



This seat was vacant due to the resignation of long time Board Member Charles Cruise, who has relocated out of the school district. We appreciate the service provided by Mr. Cruise to the school district and the community. He was always a pleasure to work with.

Mr. Carter posted the position and accepted letters of interest and resumes. Ms. Austill was the only applicant.

The new Board Member attended high school in Davenport, Iowa and graduated from the University of

Northern Iowa with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Elementary Education. That was followed by a Master of Arts degree from Northern Arizona University, also in Elementary Education with a Reading Specialist endorsement. Mr. Carter spoke with members of the school leadership and individually with seated Governing Board Members for their input prior to making the appointment.

Her experience as a teacher will continue to be beneficial. He is confident that Ms. Austill will provide her best efforts in serving the public in this position.

MIRACULOUS OUTCOME TO NEARLY DEADLY ROLLOVER. **STARK REMINDER THAT SEATBELTS SAVE LIVES.**

YCSO RELEASE

On Saturday July 9, 2022, around 3pm Yavapai County Sheriff's Office deputies were dispatched to a single vehicle roll over on Iron Springs Road. The vehicle failed to navigate a curve safely and went on the shoulder of the road before striking some large granite boulders and finally rolling over.



Deputies confirmed that the seatbelt was in the locked-out position indicating that it was on at the time of the accident. "I'm confident that that if this person wasn't wearing the seatbelt, they would not have survived the accident. This is a stark reminder that seatbelts save lives", said YCSO Sergeant Lewis.

YCSO will continue doing speed details on Iron Springs Road as well as other County roadways with a focus on seatbelt enforcement, reminding citizens to Slow Down and Buckle Up.

I-40 BRIDGE PROJECT UPDATE

New eastbound I-40 detour route for Seligman area drivers begins July 13 as work continues on bridge project west of Seligman

The Arizona Department of Transportation advises Seligman area drivers to plan for additional travel time to access eastbound Interstate 40 when a new temporary detour goes into effect at 8 a.m. Wednesday, July 13.

The new temporary detour from northbound Anvil Rock Road to eastbound I-40:

Drivers will first travel westbound on I-40 and then follow the detour signs to the Jolly Road exit (Exit 103) to cross over I-40 and proceed eastbound on I-40. This is approximately a 12-mile detour.

The temporary detour from southbound Anvil Rock Road to westbound I-40 remains the same: Drivers will first travel eastbound on I-40 and then follow detour signs to cross over I-40 on a paved section of temporary road to proceed westbound on I-40. This is approximately a 1-mile detour.

The detours are needed while construction continues on the Anvil Rock Road Bridge rehabilitation project over I-40.

Motorists should also plan for the following ongoing travel restrictions that are currently in place:

East- and westbound I-40 reduced to one lane in each direction under the Anvil Rock Road Bridge throughout the duration of the construction project.

An 18-foot width restriction through the work zone. The speed limit is reduced in the work zone.

During the bridge deck demolition, deck pouring and bridge barrier pouring operations, there will be times when full closures of I-40 will be necessary. To minimize traffic disruptions, the full closures will occur overnight, and traffic will be detoured around the work zone.

The \$2.7 million project, expected to be completed this fall, includes the removal and replacement of the existing bridge deck, which is the top surface of the bridge that motorists drive on, as well as the approach slabs, guardrail and pavement markings.

On Monday July 11, 2022, at 11:25am, Yavapai County Sheriff's Deputies were dispatched to the fire station on SR 169 in Dewey, where a male reportedly walked in suffering from multiple life-threatening gunshot wounds.

Upon arrival to the fire station, Deputies learned that the man was being flown to a Phoenix hospital for care.

This is an ongoing investigation and YCSO is asking for the public's help in locating Lana Mia Drucilla Reiber in connection with this incident. Reiber is considered an investigative lead at this time.
